Complete this section if you are not required to have a Minnesota tax ID number.

- I am selling only nontaxable items.
- I am not making any sales at the event.
- I participate in a direct selling plan, selling for \_\_\_\_\_ (name of company), and the home office or top distributor has a Minnesota tax ID number and remits the sales tax on my behalf.
- This is a nonprofit organization that meets the exemption requirements described below:
  - Candy sold for fundraising purposes by a nonprofit organization that provides educational and social activities for young people primarily aged 18 and under (MS 297A.70, subd. 13[a][4]).
  - Youth or senior citizen group with fundraising receipts up to \$20,000 per year (\$10,000 or less before January 1, 2015)(MS 297A.70, subd. 13[b][1]).
  - A nonprofit organization that meets all the criteria set forth in MS 297A.70, subd. 14.

**Food vendors will check this box**

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**If you cannot sell your product but just displaying it you would check this box**

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Crafters that do not have a MN Tax ID# you can obtain one simply by going here, if you decide not to obtain one you will need to fill out that part of the form with the last 4 digits of your social security number.
